Position Summary: The Green Heart Apprentice is a 12-month opportunity for recent high school graduates interested in furthering their educational and professional skills to work, learn, and train as a year-round employee for The Green Heart Project. The Apprentice is supervised by the Program Manager for learning and involvement in many aspects of the organization, gaining practical experience and developing skills in sustainable agriculture, lesson facilitation, garden maintenance, organization, logistics, and administration.

Responsibilities and Duties:

- Assists Garden Educators with lesson delivery, administrative and logistical support, and classroom management.
- Assist in all components of crop production and sustainable growing (crop planning, harvesting, planting, weeding, mulching, etc.) throughout partner and affiliate sites
- Supports other operations at the Urban Farm, to include routine farm and gardening support
- Lead volunteer work.
- Assist with garden building, improvement projects and maintenance of infrastructure within school and urban farm garden site(s), including storage and built structures
- Support efforts for Weekly Market operation
- Assist with planning, preparation, and execution of Urban Farm field trips.
- Assists with soliciting schools and organizations to participate in field trips to the Urban Farm.
- Assist with other tasks including public events when needed
- Enroll in and make satisfactory progress toward completion of the Sustainable Agriculture Certificate in Applied Science offered by Trident Tech.

- Must have a driver's license and vehicle or reliable transportation for travel to Green Heart garden sites.

WORKING CONDITIONS:
